Code of Conduct for Creekside Enrichment

- Don't do or say anything mean or offensive.
- Be responsible for your own work.
- Follow the rules of the school and your teachers.

- Express how you're feeling or what you need in helpful and appropriate ways.
- Resolve disagreements in acceptable ways. (Asking a teacher is helpful.)

Consequences for not following the Code of Conduct

Knowing the expectations and consequences will help you to make good choices that support a positive learning environment.

- If you are not following the Code of Conduct you will receive one verbal warning.
- If these behaviors continue you will be asked to leave the classroom and sit with the Enrichment Coordinator.
- If you are unable to follow the Code of Conduct when you return to your class then your parent will be called to pick you up.
- You will also miss the following week of Enrichment.
